



TCA CONSENT FOR SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES

As required by Florida Statute 1014.06(1), the parent or legal guardian must authorize healthcare services to be provided for their student by a healthcare practitioner or their delegate, as defined in F.S. 456.001 and 1006.062, should the need arise for such treatment, while their student is under the supervision of the school.

Separate parent/guardian authorizations will be required for the school clinic staff or school staff to administer daily or as-needed prescribed or over-the-counter medications, conduct medical procedures, or provide medical treatment such as following anaphylactic, asthmatic, diabetic, and other approved care plans of care.
